# Squid



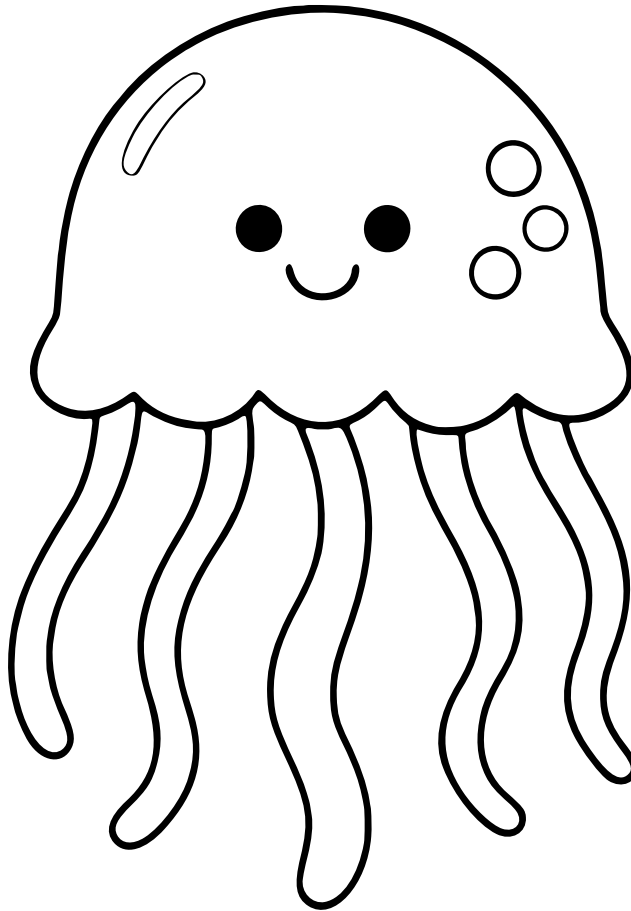
